### **Program Hours:**

**Wednesday 10 am to 5 pm**

**Thursday 10 am to 5 pm**

**Friday 10 am to 5 pm**

*Closed on Statutory Holidays*

**Cost: Annual fee of \$150.00 for meal costs.**

### **Criteria for day program:**

**Members must be minimum of 19 years of age to attend and be responsible for self care.**

### **DROP IN SERVICES**

*No referral required to access service*

### **Program Hours:**

**Tuesday 10:00 am to 4:00 pm**

**Meal card 20 meals / \$70.00 or \$4.00 / meal**

### **Criteria for drop in:**

**-Members must be minimum of 19 years of age to attend.**

**-Members requiring personal assistance must be accompanied by an attendant.**

**-An appointment must be setup with Program Coordinator prior to attending.**

Programs are developed based on individuals interests and choices.

Members decide the goals and the objectives of services provided. This must however align with the program budget, as well as the abilities assessed by staff on a person to person basis.
